*Early submission is advised for all applicants*

**ENROLMENT AND FEES**

The cost of the 8-day course is £2,300. This includes single room accommodation, most meals, tuition, admissions and travel by private coach. Airfares are not included.

**Scholarships** – Some full and partial scholarships are available for qualified candidates\*. If considering a scholarship, applicants should decide how much they can contribute to the cost through their institution/company and/or their own resources. A statement of financial need is required.

A letter of reference is required UNLESS you have attended an Attingham Trust course in the last 5 years.

**Closing date for applications is 22nd January 2010**

All applicants will be notified by the end of February 2010. If awarded a place, an invoice will be sent and a deposit of £500 should be made at this time. The balance of fees is due, without further notice, by March 31st. These payments should be made in £sterling to ‘The Attingham Trust’ by bankers draft or bank transfer.

Participants are strongly advised to insure against cancellation as no refunds will be made following payment, unless the place can be filled by another suitable candidate. In such a case, an administrative fee of £120 will be applied.

*The Attingham Trust reserves the right to make changes to the advertised programme. It should be noted that (a) this course is intensive and physically strenuous and (b) specialist diets, apart from vegetarian, cannot always be catered for.*
